A new call for proposals under Tempus IV will be published in October 2007. The planned deadline for submission of project proposals is February-March 2008.

Financed by MEDA, the Tempus programme funds cooperation projects in the areas of curriculum development and innovation, teacher training, university management, and structural reforms in higher education in partner countries.
